Please check back for further updates as new information becomes available. Sand bags are available for purchase at:



The Flood Warning continues for The Saint Joseph River Michigan at Three Rivers * until further notice. * At 4 AM Wednesday the stage was 7.7 feet and rising. * Minor flooding is occurring and Moderate flooding is forecast. * Flood stage is 7.0 feet. * Forecast...The river will rise to a crest near 10.5 feet around 7 AM Saturday February 24 and begin falling. * At 10.6 feet...Expect moderate flooding of Scidmore Park. Flooding of the basements of several homes and businesses along south Main Street in the vicinity of the lumber yard can be expected.
