Citizens are urged to **STAY OFF THE RIVERS**. High water levels cause strong currents making the water unsafe.

Please do not attempt to drive or traverse through barricaded streets and roadways. Water levels are expected to crest sometime Saturday February 24, 2018, at high flood stage.

Continued major flooding is expected at this time and flooding may increase with further rain. For residents in the flood affected areas, it is requested that those residents make preparations to evacuate their homes due to flooding basements that may result in an interruption of their gas and electrical utility's.


